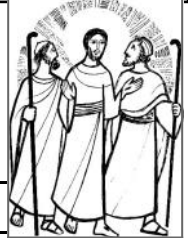

The Sunday Readings

Peter is preaching to the people about the risen Christ. He does not shrink from reminding them that they shouted for Barabas to be freed and for the innocent Christ to be killed. After all, God has foretold the suffering of His Son through the prophets. Neither does Peter shrink from telling them what to do next: repent and turn to God so that their sins may be wiped out. This is essentially what Jesus Himself says in today's gospel. The disciples are confused by Christ's resurrection to begin with. He needs to help them understand both by showing His wounds and explaining the teaching of the prophets. Not only that, but in continuing Jesus's command to take bread and break it they find that He is known and present through this great sacrament of the Altar. And then the results of this: the preaching of repentance and forgiveness of sins in His name. Which is what Peter is doing in the first reading.

ARRANGING A WEDDING

Congratulations on your engagement! Please speak to one of the clergy in the first place to make arrangements for your wedding. You will need a meeting with the Parish Priest to go through all that needs to be done. About six months' notice at least is desirable: but it's never too soon.



ARRANGING A BAPTISM

(CHRISTENING) for BABIES & YOUNG CHILDREN

Congratulations on the birth of your child! Baptism is arranged by appointment. It usually happens at 12.15 p.m. on a Sunday **or** at either Sunday Mass. Parents should collect a form **after Sunday Mass**. For the baptism of children over four and of adults see the parish priest.

MAKING YOUR CONFESSION

Confession, the sacrament of reconciliation, is available on Saturday mornings 9.40 a.m.-10.20 a.m., on Sundays before 6 p.m. Mass and by arrangement with the parish priest. Our God is a God of mercy!

ADORING THE LORD EXPOSITION

There are regular opportunities each week to pray before the Blessed Sacrament exposed on the altar. Saturdays from 9.30 a.m. (following Mass) and Mondays 7.00 p.m.
